EARL GREY LATTE

a cool-toned, soft brown with natural veining woven throughout.

OAT

a warm natural wood with a lightly-textured grain.

POPPYSEED

a charcoal black *just* soft enough to show the natural wood texture.

CHOOSING *your stain*

Spaces and subject matter with cooler-tones in their accents, paint colour, and details, including blues, purples, greys, and whites.

Spaces and subject matter with warm tones and rustic details, including reds, yellow, orange, browns, and cream/off-white tones.

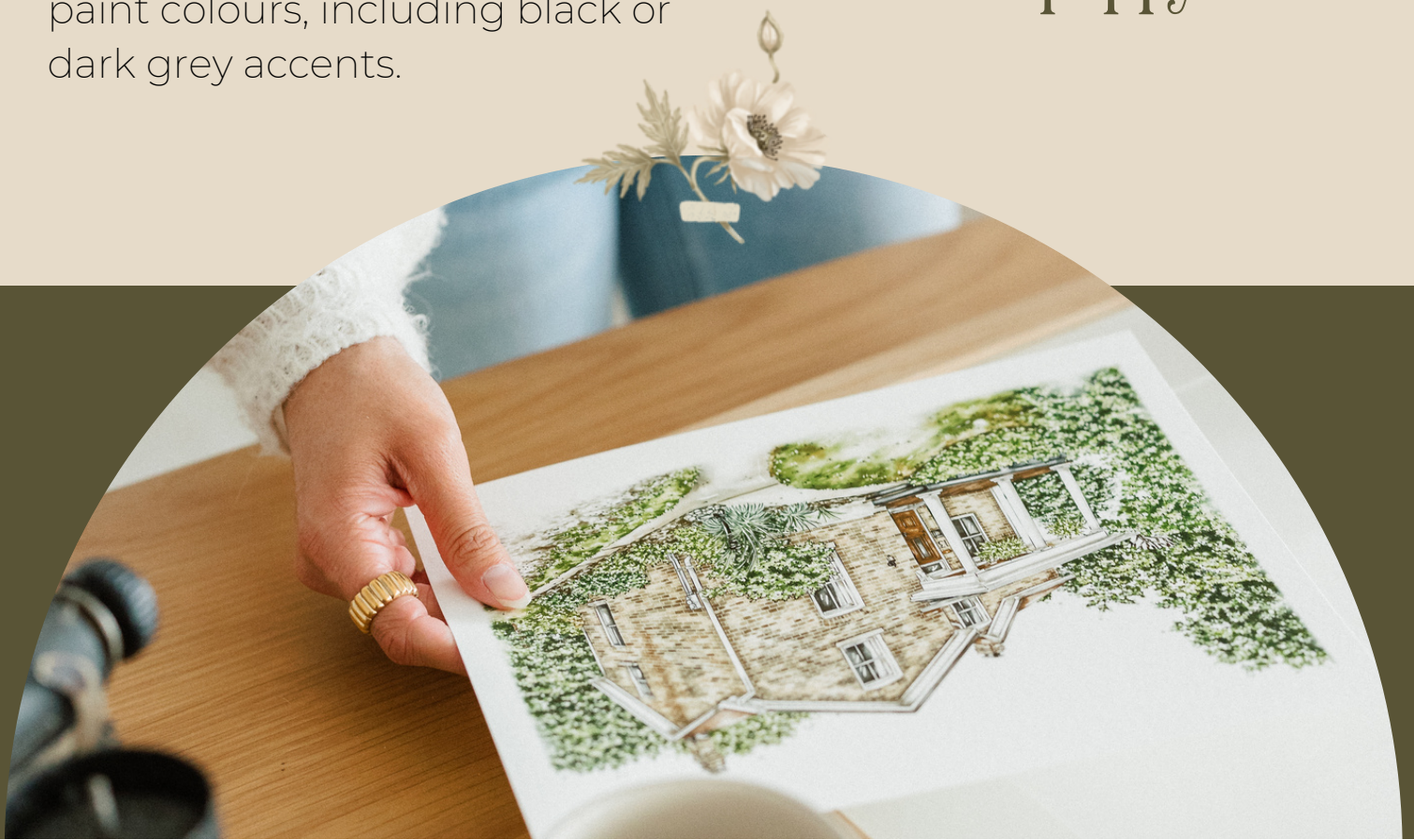

CHOOSING *your glass*



consideration no. 1

Your first consideration is whether you will be picking up your artwork in person in Downtown Burlington, Ontario or having it shipped to you! Regular and museum glass frames are available for pickup *only* while acrylic glaze is eligible for shipping.

consideration no. 2

When it comes to presenting your artwork in your home, your glass is more important than you think! I always recommend upgrading to museum glass, especially if your artwork will be hung in a sunny spot, because it offers a noticeable difference in the overall clarity of your piece so you can see all of those details shine through.
